### Addendum

This chart identifies specific time windows where "cyclic energy" re-emerges to influence market momentum.

#### 1. Solar Weather and Geomagnetic Indicators

The protocol places significant emphasis on how space weather influences market behavior, often claiming these factors can override traditional analyst consensus.

**Bullish Indicators (Rise):** M or X Class Flares, "sweet spot" KP storms, and higher 2mev electron activity.

**Bearish Indicators (Drop):** KP storms out of the "sweet spot," forecasted jumps in solar wind speed (SWS), and KP storms occurring with low flare activity.

**Momentum:** Stock activity may continue to rise for up to 48 hours after a "Time-Gate" ends if solar weather remains in the "green zone".

#### 2. The "Time-Gate" Calculation Protocol

The methodology relies on identifying recurring energy cycles by comparing current dates to historical data.

**Locating the Gate:** Users are instructed to find a "Past Time-Gate" from exactly one year prior and identify the strongest performing stocks from that week.

**Precision Timing:** The exact date for a current "Time-Gate" is determined by finding the Lunar Node that occurs ahead of the previous year's node.

**UTC Conversion:** Precision is vital; all Lunar Node data is in UTC, which must be converted (e.g., UTC is 8 hours ahead of Australian time) to ensure the scan begins on the correct day.

#### 3. Financial Sentiment and Mentions

The document uses a "Pre-Gateway Checklist" to gauge market sentiment through specific platforms.

**Article Mentions:** The protocol tracks the number of mentions for stocks like Apple, Microsoft, and Exxon Mobil across Seeking Alpha, The Motley Fool, and Zacks Equity Research .

**Volume Significance:** A stock that receives the highest number of mentions relative to others is expected to perform more strongly during the Time-Gate week.

**Analyst Consensus:** Analysts are rated on a scale of 1 to 10, though this consensus is only considered valid when solar weather is stable.

#### 4. Specific Trading Phenomena

Several unique effects are defined to guide the timing of trades:

**Well Effect:** A forecasted jump in solar wind speed that creates a "drop"; the protocol recommends trading only before this effect occurs. The well effect is the period when geomagnetic activity is just about to increase after a period of calm.

**Planetary Double Ingress:** Described as mostly negative, occurring when multiple planets (e.g., Mars/Mercury) change signs simultaneously, often leading to market drops.

#### **Heart-Math and ARV Priming Protocol**

The most unconventional aspect of the document is a 10-step biological and mental "priming" sequence used to retrieve market information.

**Preparation:** This involves taking a B-vitamin mix 24 hours in advance and using pink noise with earphones.

**PSI Chip Activation:** "PSI chips" are used as focal points for energy. They are "primed" 24 hours before a session at Local Sidereal Time (LST) peak.

**Mental Focus:** The practitioner uses Heart-Math techniques to "freeze" an emotion of appreciation while focusing on an exact future date and time for an index like the S&P 500.

**Information Retrieval:** After "pouring energy" into the chip, the user draws the first thing that comes to mind on a tablet, which is considered the correct market forecast.
